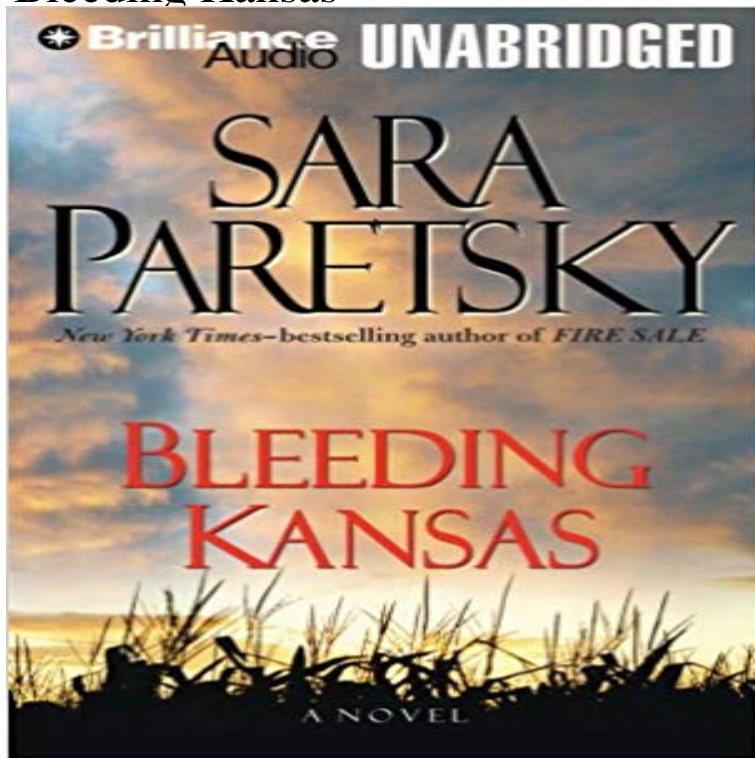


## Bleeding Kansas
