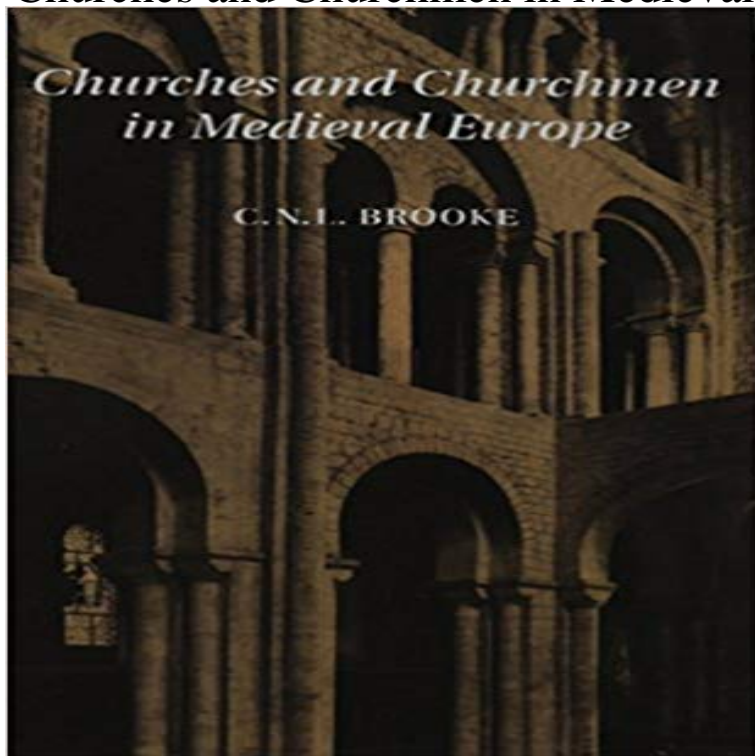


## Churches and Churchmen in Medieval Europe
