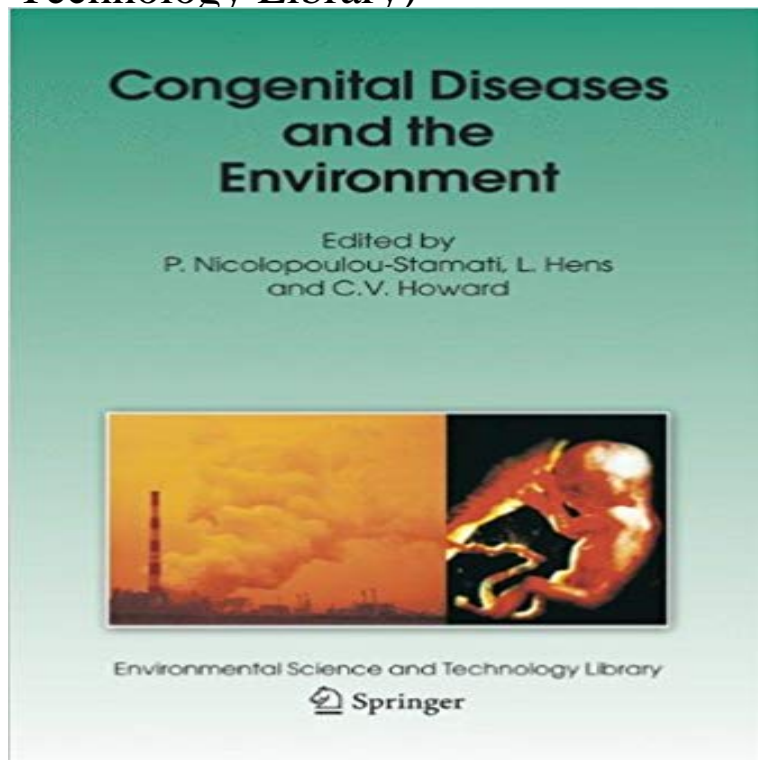


Congenital Diseases and the Environment (Environmental Science and Technology Library)
