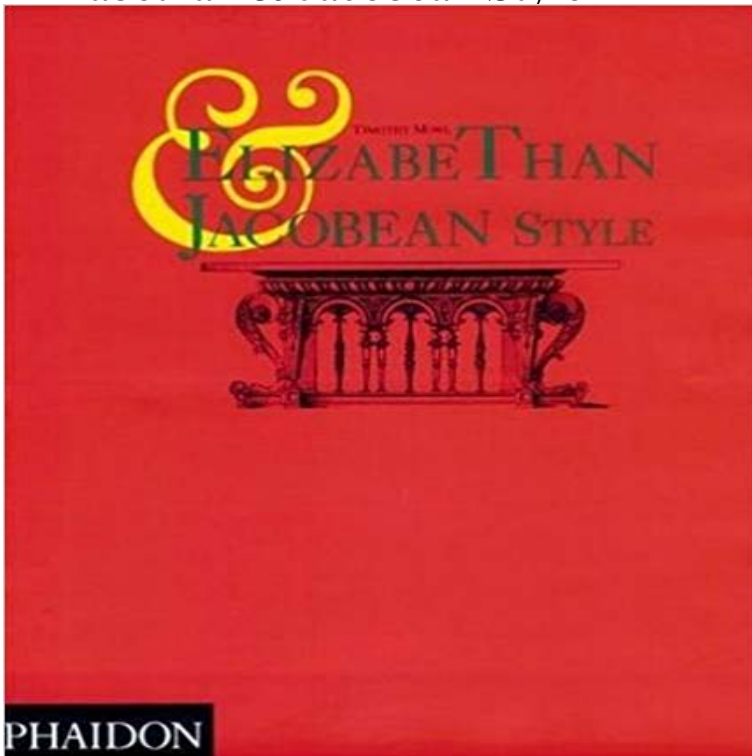


Elizabethan & Jacobean Style
