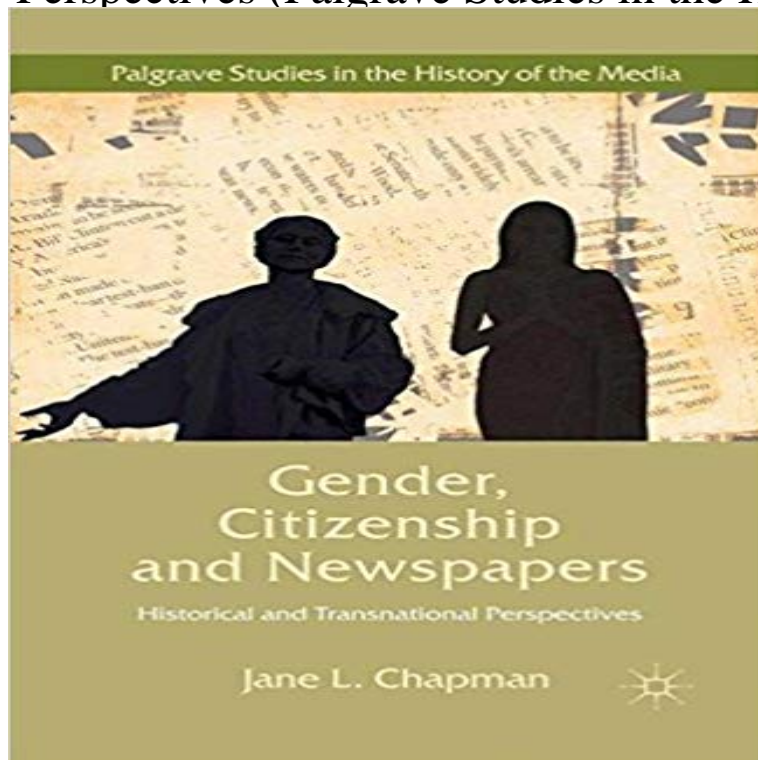


Gender, Citizenship and Newspapers: Historical and Transnational Perspectives (Palgrave Studies in the History of the Media)
