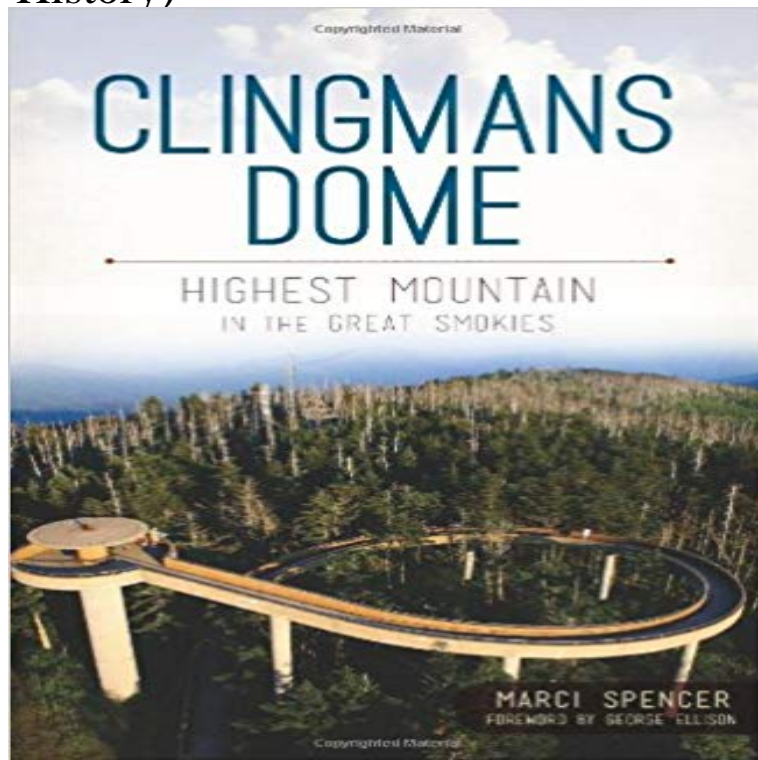


Clingmans Dome:: Highest Mountain in the Great Smokies (Natural History)
