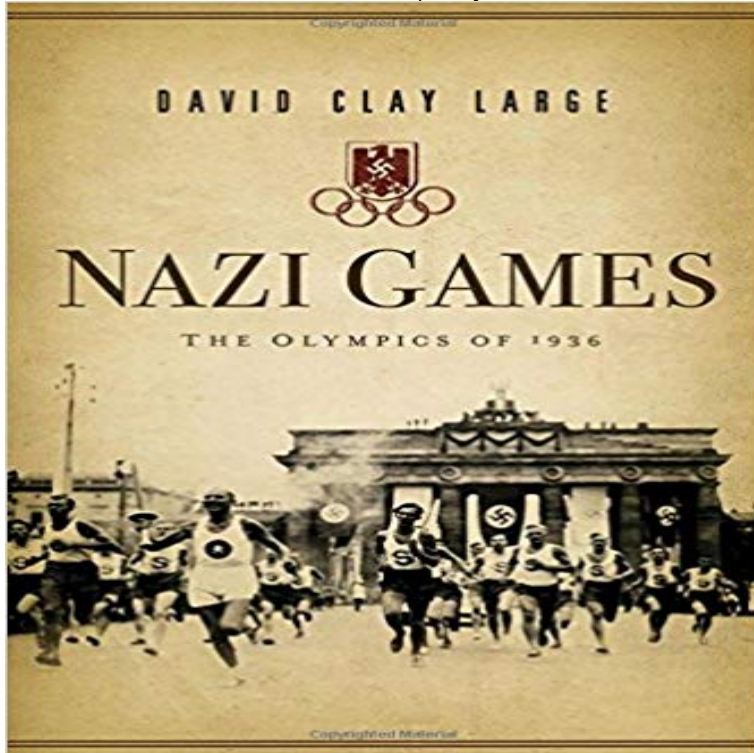


## Nazi Games: The Olympics of 1936
