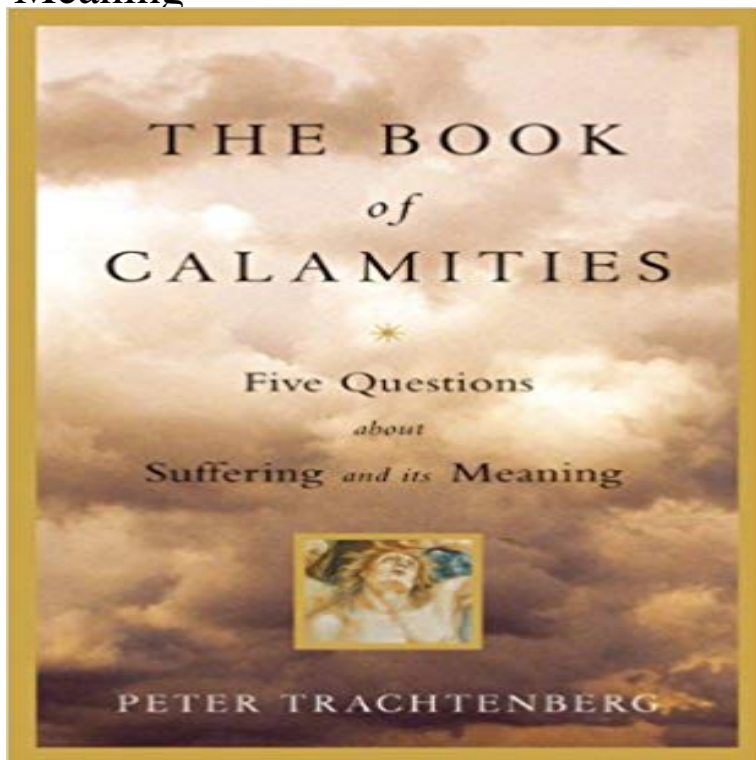


The Book of Calamities: Five Questions About Suffering and Its Meaning
