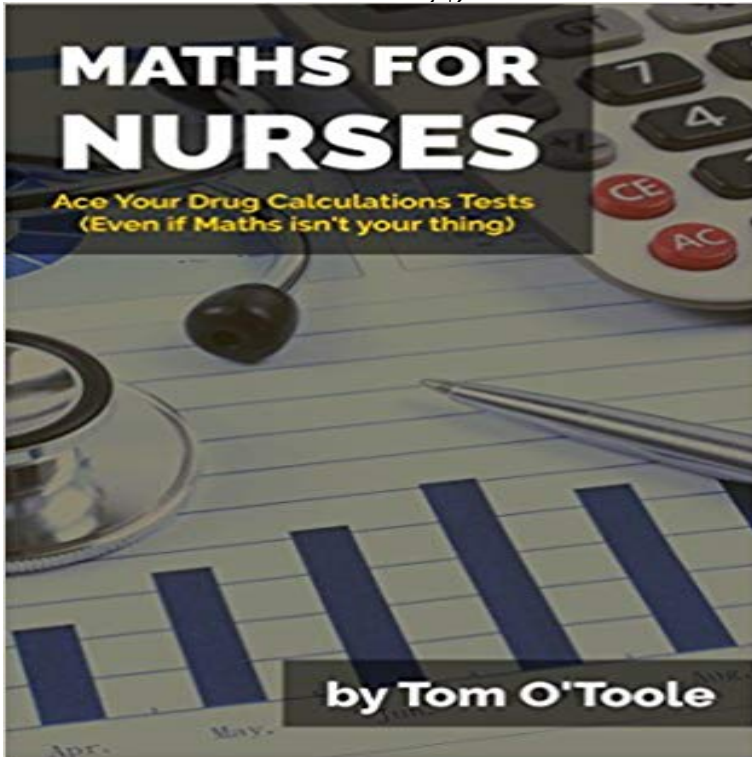


Maths For Nurses: How to Ace Your Drug Calculations Tests (Even if Maths Isn't Your Thing)

intravenous dosages, dosage per weight, multiple doses, infusion rates, fluid balance and burns. Again, you will find clear explanations, step-by-step examples, Have a Go questions as you learn and Practice Questions at the end of each chapter, with access to fully worked solutions to every question. At the end of each section of the book, you will find a collection of practice exam papers for you have a go at and put your skills to the test. The first collection contains four practice basic numeracy papers that examine the skills developed in the first part of the book. The second collection is made up of four practice drug calculations papers that focus in on the applied skills of section two of the book, and that replicate the kinds of calculation that you will be called upon to make in your nursing practice.
