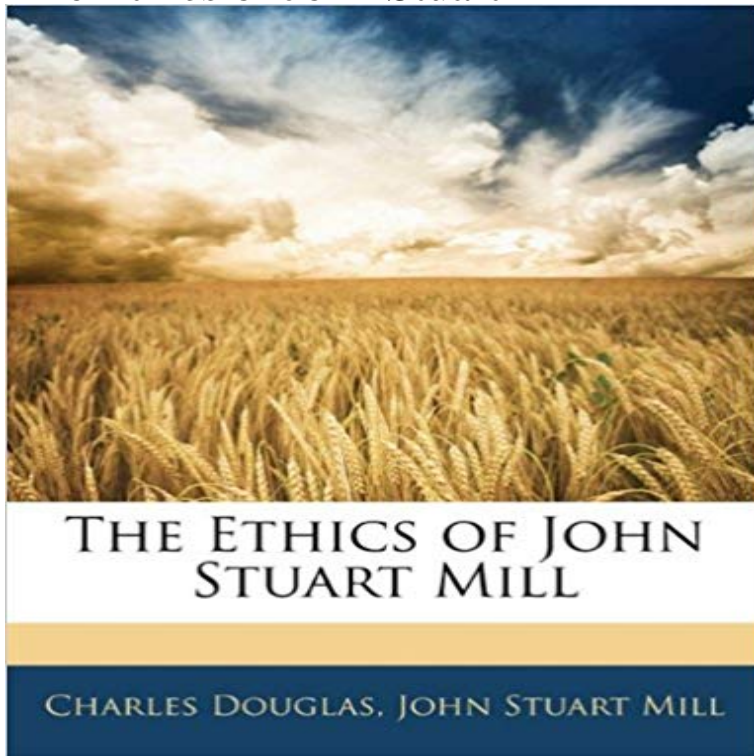


# The Ethics of John Stuart Mill
