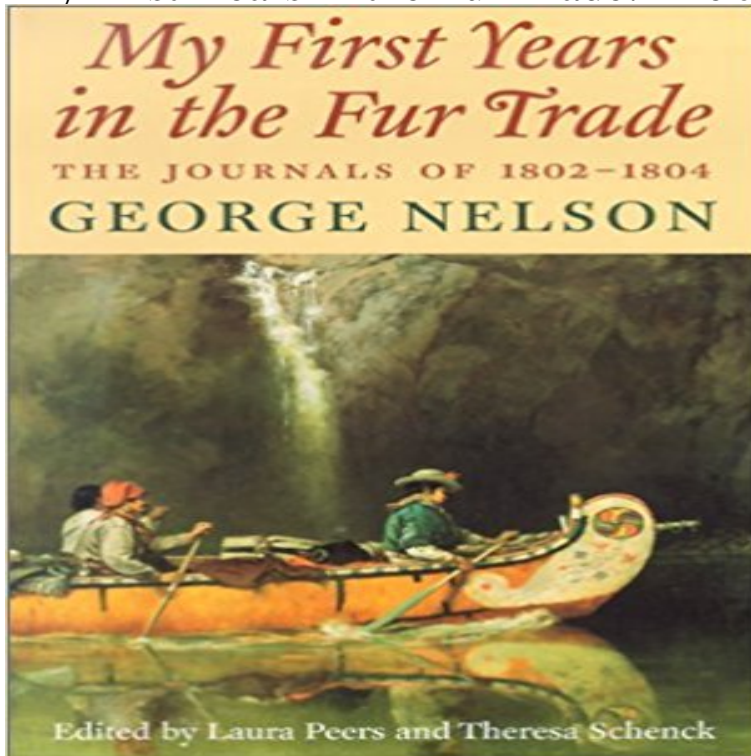


My First Years in the Fur Trade: The Journals of 1802-1804
