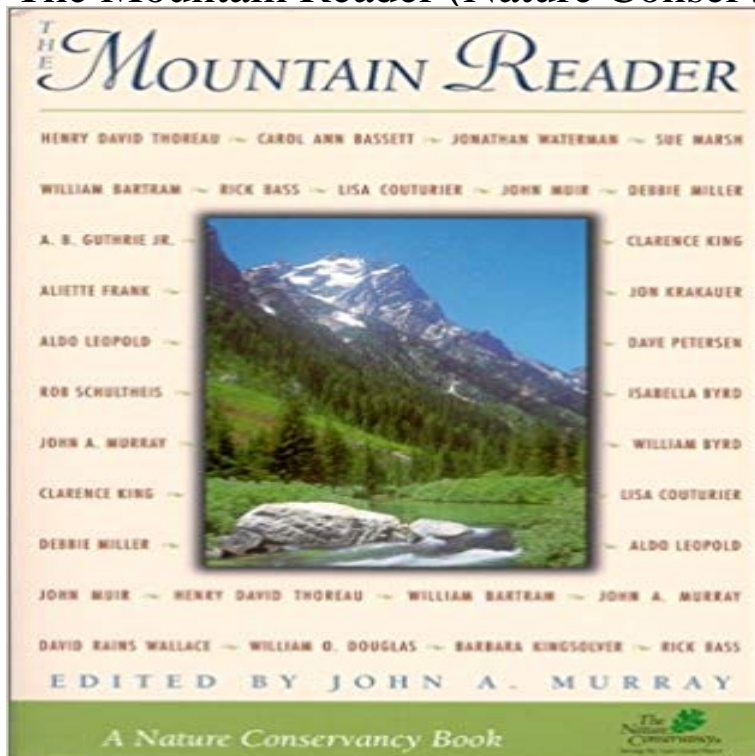


The Mountain Reader (Nature Conservancy Books)
