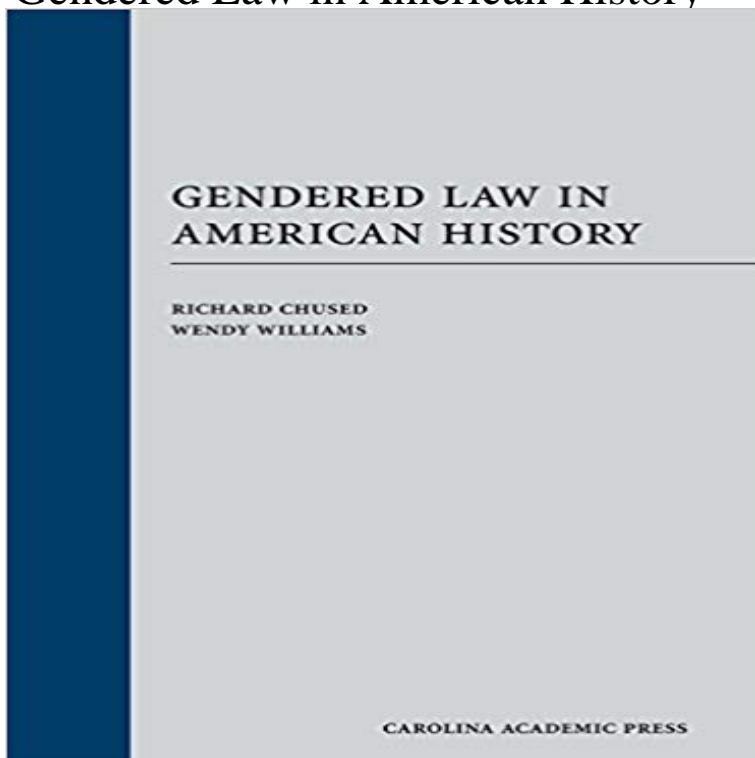


Gendered Law in American History
