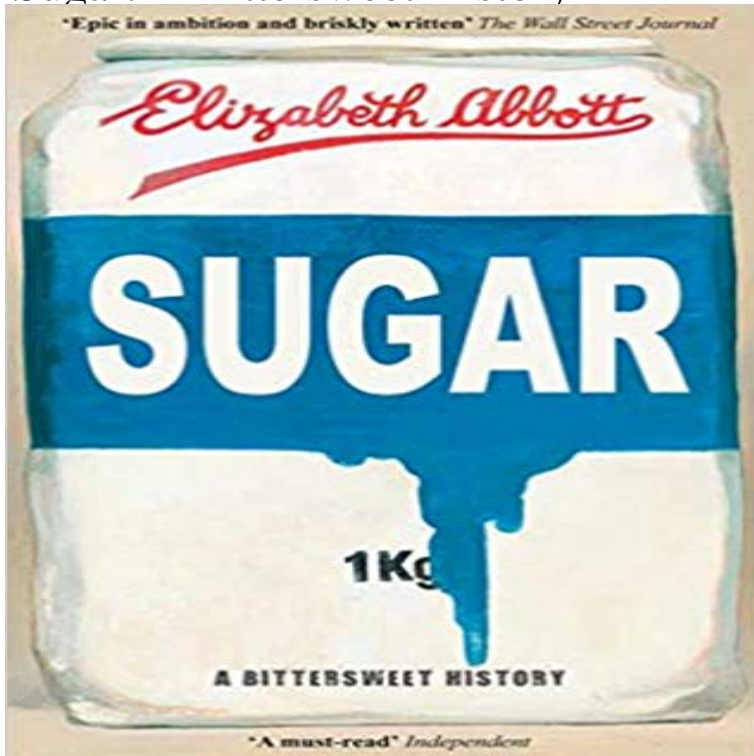


Sugar: A Bittersweet History
