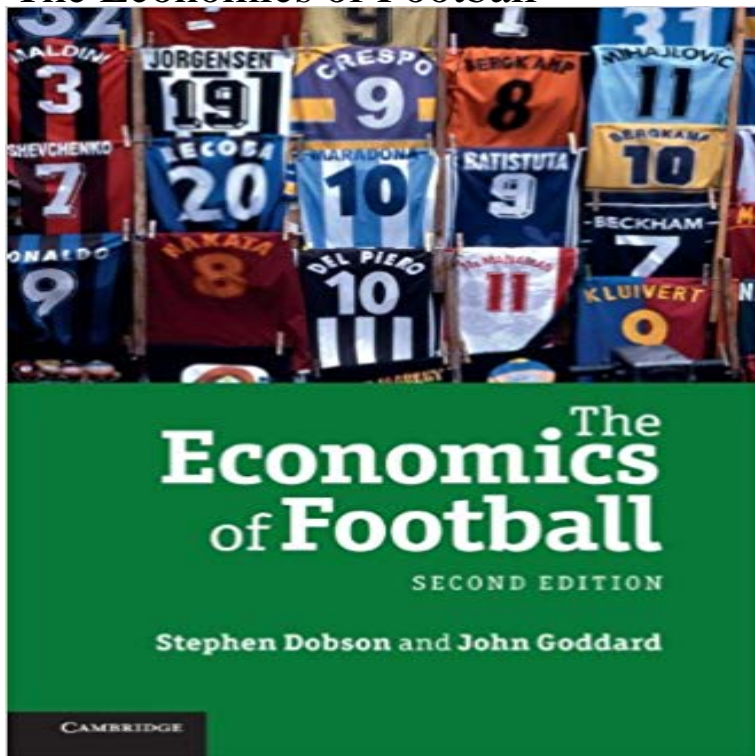


The Economics of Football
