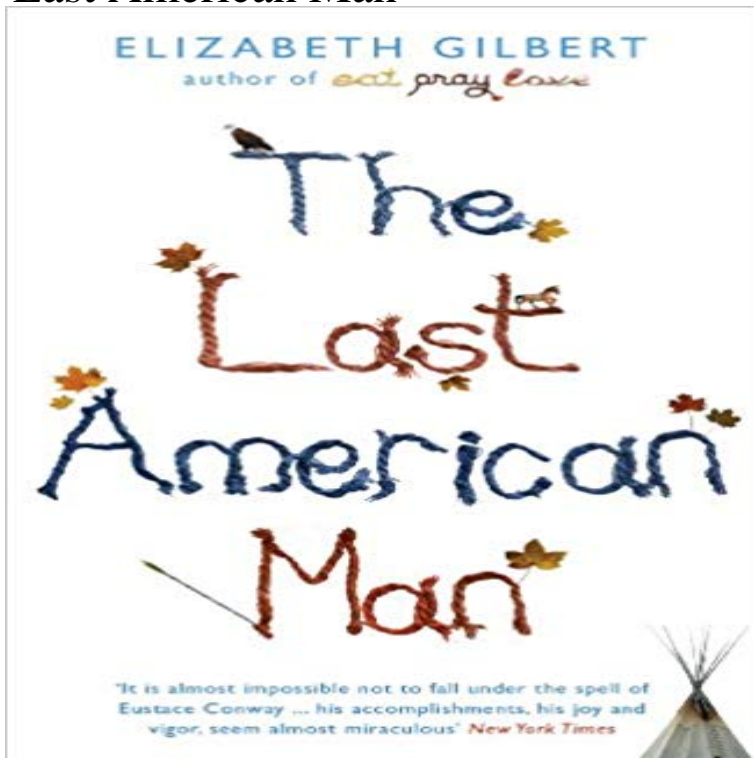


Last American Man
