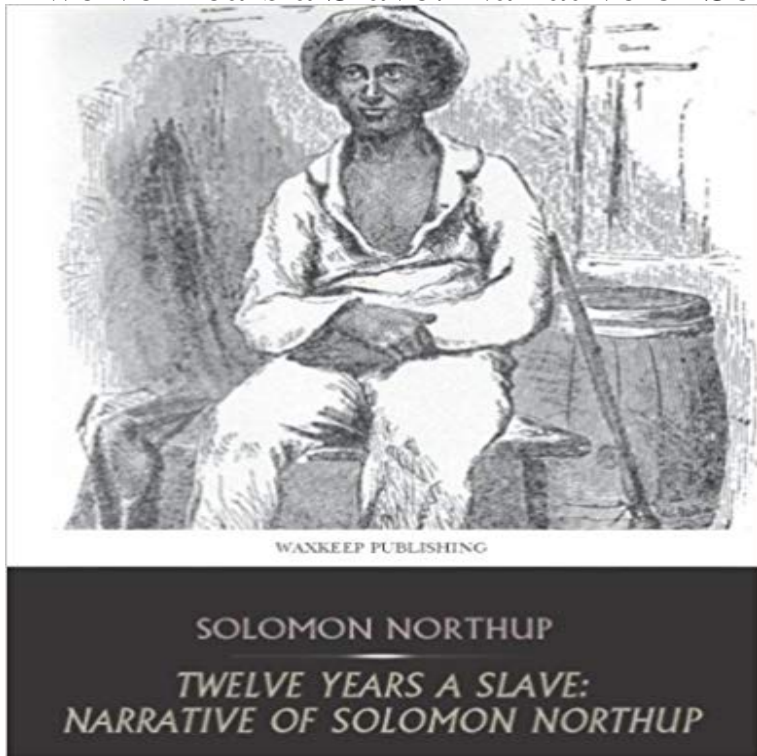


# Twelve Years a Slave: Narrative of Solomon Northup
