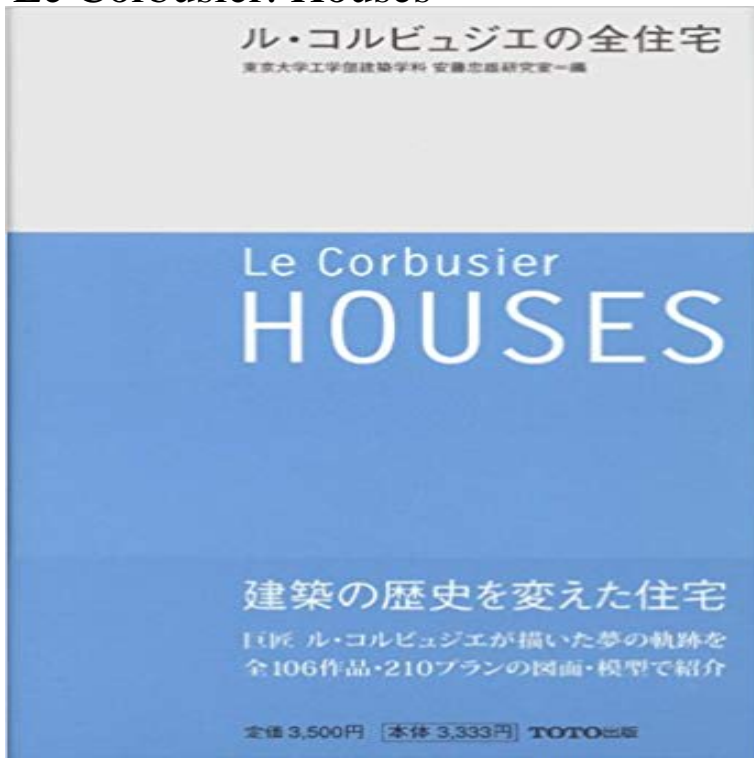


Le Corbusier: Houses
